



1. International Day of Light: A Ray of hope (16th May, 2021)



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
12. World No Tobacco Day (31st May, 2023)


13. Eid-al-adha Celebration (29th June, 2023)


25. E-Summit: Embracing Socio-economic Diversity through Culture (3rd-5th April, 2024)
