During this workshop techniques like Mail Merge, Advance Filter, Advance Sorting, Relative Reference and Absolute Reference, D-Function, Sub-Total, Charts, COUNTIF, SUMIF & AVERAGEIF, IF Conditional Function, Conditional Formatting, Data Validation, Pivot Table & Pivot Chart, Series & Macros, V Look Up, Goal Seek, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Google Docs, Google Forms, Google Quiz were some prominent techniques were taught to students with workplace related examples. In addition to these excel techniques students were taught large number of excel short-cuts in order to improve workplace related task efficiency.

Executive Summary

Q4: What are some of the shortcuts in Excel that can significantly boost productivity?


