

Mr. Saha stressed the need for precision in CV content. He advised participants to tailor their CVs to specific job roles by highlighting relevant experiences and skills. The importance of using quantifiable achievements rather than vague descriptions was a key point in his discussion. This approach not only makes the CV more impactful but also demonstrates the candidate's ability to deliver results.

Personal Branding:

Another crucial aspect covered was personal branding. Mr. Saha explained how a CV is an opportunity for candidates to market themselves effectively. He encouraged participants to reflect on their unique strengths and achievements, integrating these into their CVs to create a distinctive personal brand. This personal touch can significantly influence a recruiter's perception.

Common Mistakes and Best Practices:

These include errors in spelling or grammar, using a one-size-fits-all approach, and failing to update the CV regularly. Mr. Saha provided practical tips for avoiding these mistakes and ensuring that the CV remains relevant and error-free.

Following the presentation, an interactive Q&A session allowed participants to seek clarification on specific points and engage in deeper discussions. The questions ranged from how to handle gaps in employment to the best ways to present academic
