The Department of Applied Sciences and Humanities organized a one-day workshop on **Discover the Magic of Reading** on September 25, 2020. **Ms. Radhika**, an assistant professor at the department of Applied Sciences and Humanities, conducted the workshop as a resource person. At the outset, the resource person was introduced and welcomed by the coordinator of the event **Dr. Nisha**. Ms. Radhika opened the workshop with a personal narrative about her own journey with reading. She shared how reading has influenced her life, shaped her perspectives, and provided solace during challenging times. The workshop included a comprehensive overview of various literary genres, including fiction, non-fiction, fantasy, historical fiction, science fiction, and poetry. Ms. Radhika provided examples of notable works in each genre.

Ms. Radhika discussed practical strategies for setting achievable reading goals. She emphasized the importance of consistency and recommended starting with short stories or novellas to build momentum. Tips for integrating reading into busy schedules were provided. Students learned how to create a reading routine that fits their lifestyle, including using digital resources and audio books. The workshop covered techniques for active reading, such as annotating, summarizing, and questioning. Ms. Radhika demonstrated how these techniques can deepen understanding and retention.

Students participated in a book swap activity where they exchanged books with one another. This allowed them to discover new authors and genres based on recommendations from peers. As part of a creative exercise, students wrote short pieces inspired by their favorite books or genres. They shared their writings with the group, fostering a sense of community and shared enthusiasm for literature. In the last segment, Ms. Radhika introduced students to digital reading resources, including e-books and audio books. She highlighted the benefits of these formats and demonstrated how to access and use various platforms. The workshop culminated with a vote of thanks presented by (**Prof.**) **Dr. Vinay Khatri**.




Fig 1. Participants attending the online workshop
