On March 16, 2021, the department of Applied Sciences and Humanities hosted an online one-day workshop on Enhance Writing by Grammar Essentials which was conducted by Ms. Radhika as a resource person. At the very outset the resource person was introduced with a warm welcome by Dr. Vinay Khatri (HOD ASH) and the coordinator of the event Dr. Nisha. Ms. Radhika started by emphasizing the significance of grammar in writing. She explained that correct grammar enhances communication by ensuring clarity and precision. The workshop started with an overview of common grammar mistakes that students often make in their writing, such as subject-verb agreement, punctuation errors, and misuse of pronouns. Ms. Radhika explained the rules of subject-verb agreement, providing examples and exercises for students to practice identifying and correcting errors. The session covered rules for using commas, semicolons, colons, and apostrophes correctly. Ms. Radhika demonstrated how proper punctuation enhances readability and meaning in writing.

Ms. Radhika addressed common challenges related to misplaced modifiers and dangling participles, illustrating their impact on sentence clarity and meaning. Rules for the correct usage of pronouns, including personal pronouns, indefinite pronouns, and possessive pronouns, were clarified with examples. Techniques for achieving clarity and conciseness in writing were discussed. Ms. Radhika provided strategies for avoiding run-on sentences, fragment sentences, and awkward phrasing. The workshop included guidance on using parallel structure to maintain consistency and coherence within sentences and paragraphs.

The final segment of the workshop allowed students to ask questions about specific grammar issues they encounter in their writing. Students participated in grammar exercises and drills designed to reinforce understanding and application of grammar rules discussed during the workshop. Practical editing exercises were conducted where students reviewed and corrected sample passages to identify and rectify grammar errors. At the end of the event the resource person was given a vote of thanks by (**Prof.**) **Dr. Vinay Khatri.**
