


Figure 1: Chart of the Student's Responses (Q1 to Q14 from left to right)




Figure 2: Chart of the Teacher's Responses (Q1 to Q9 from left to right)




Figure 3: Chart of the Alumi's Responses (Q1 to Q13 from left to right)
