

## (b) Bar chart representation of the student response to questions in survey

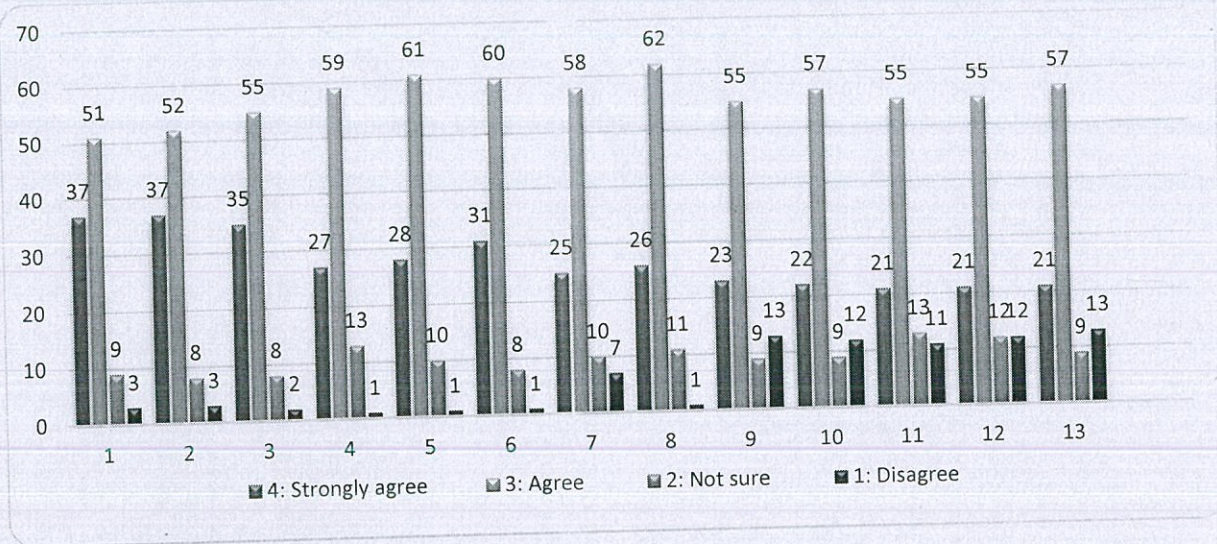



Figure 1. Chart for the students' responses (Q1 to Q15 from left to right)

## (c) Feedback observation of student survey

- Majority of the students indicated that current syllabus offers a good balance between core and applied subjects and is better than other equivalent universities. Around two thirds of the students agreed that teaching hours allocated for a particular subject were sufficient and students were well aware about course outcome which lead to better understanding of the subject matter.
- Similar proportions of students consider that department puts great efforts to improve managerial aptitude and skills in students.
- Few of the students indicated that department need to put more efforts to upscale managerial and professional skills of the students to improve chances of employability. Few students indicated that department should go for providing comprehensive road map for skill development among students to build successful career. In addition to this students also demanded that industry specific certification programmes should be advised in order to learn contemporary skills required in the industry.

(b) Bar chart representation of the teacher's response to question in survey:

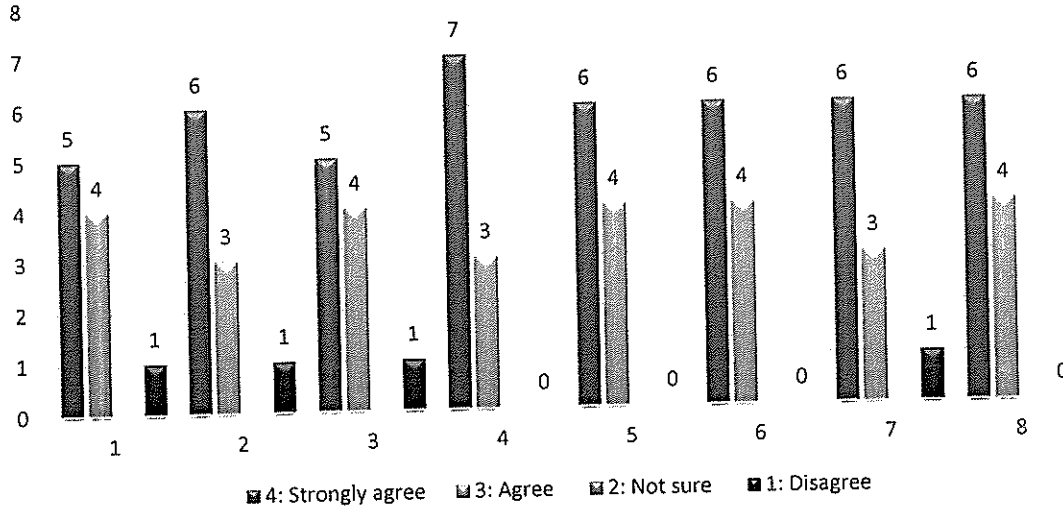


Figure 2 Chart of the Teacher's Responses (Q1 to Q8 from left to right)

## (c) Feedback observation of teacher's survey

- Majority of faculty members agree that contents and framing of the university's syllabus are suitable to industry requirements and based on present day requirements of the industry.
- Similar proportion of the faculty members strongly believes that subjects are taught at a proper pace in the classrooms in order to have a better understanding. Students were aware about the basics of the subjects being taught as the prerequisites for the current subject have been taught in previous semesters.
- Majority of the faculty members indicated that library contains all the relevant and prescribed books required to the students.
- One faculty member expressed that syllabus should be revised in order to meet industry requirements.
- Faculty members specified that some training programmes for faculties related to accreditation, entrepreneurship and business incubation should be organized.

(b) Bar chart representation of the alumni's response to question in survey:

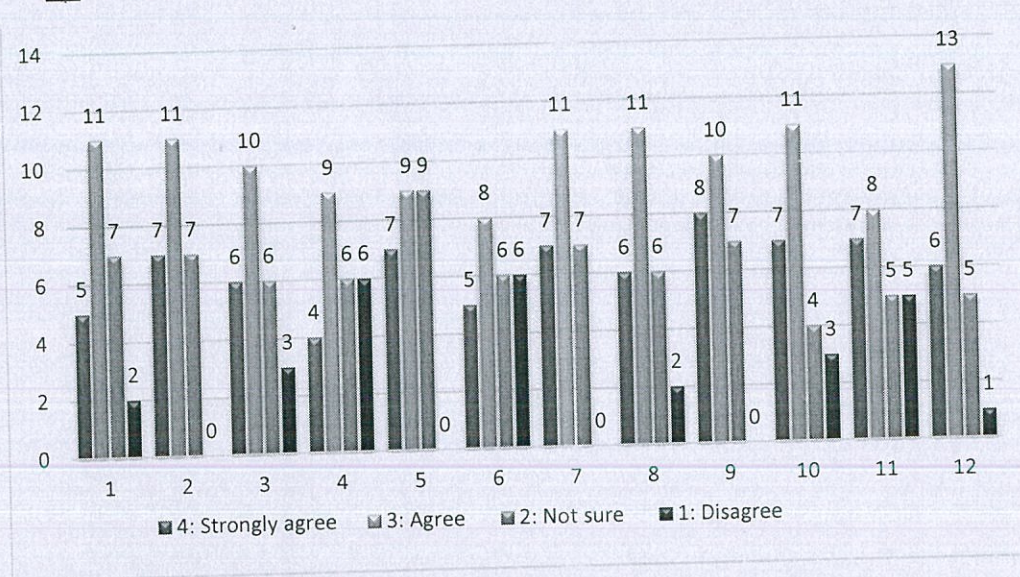


Figure 3 Chart of the Alumni's Responses (Q1 to Q12 from left to right)

## (c) Feedback observation of alumni's survey

- Majority of the alumni agreed that subjects offered under first year were highly useful to build foundations for studying further subjects and program electives offered were useful to build professional career. In addition to this similar proportion of alumni indicated that text and reference books mentioned in syllabus were useful.
- Almost half of alumni consider that curriculum offered good balance between core and applied subjects. Some of the alumni indicated that level of courses studied required up gradation while making comparison with what was studied by workplace colleagues.
- Seminars and PDPs were considered highly useful by the alumni in order to groom students and internal evaluation practices were considered to be fair and transparent by majority of the alumni.
- Few of the alumni were not satisfied with the quality of internship done and effectiveness of some value added courses like public speaking.
- Few alumni indicated that more emphasis should be given to make students aware regarding contemporary events taking place in corporate world. In addition to this students should be made aware regarding the role and power of spirituality and positive thinking to build successful career.
