

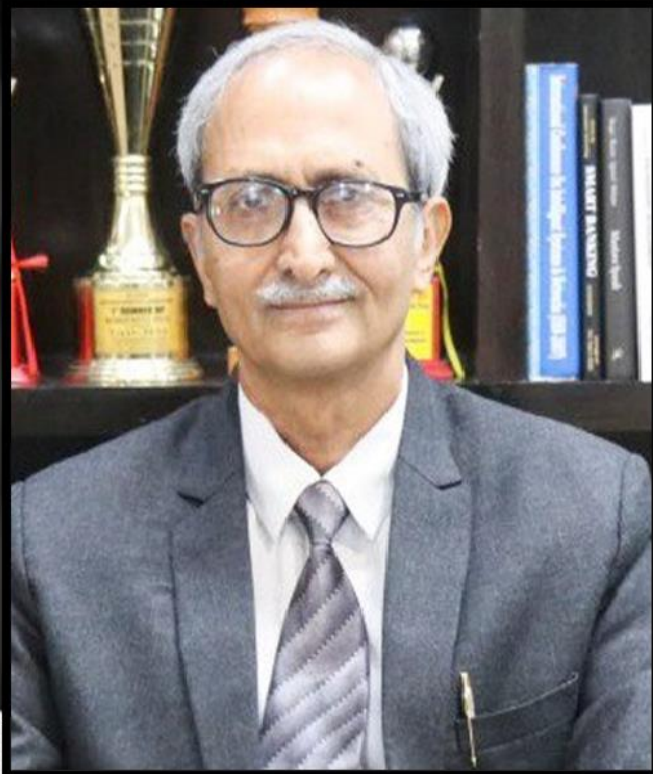

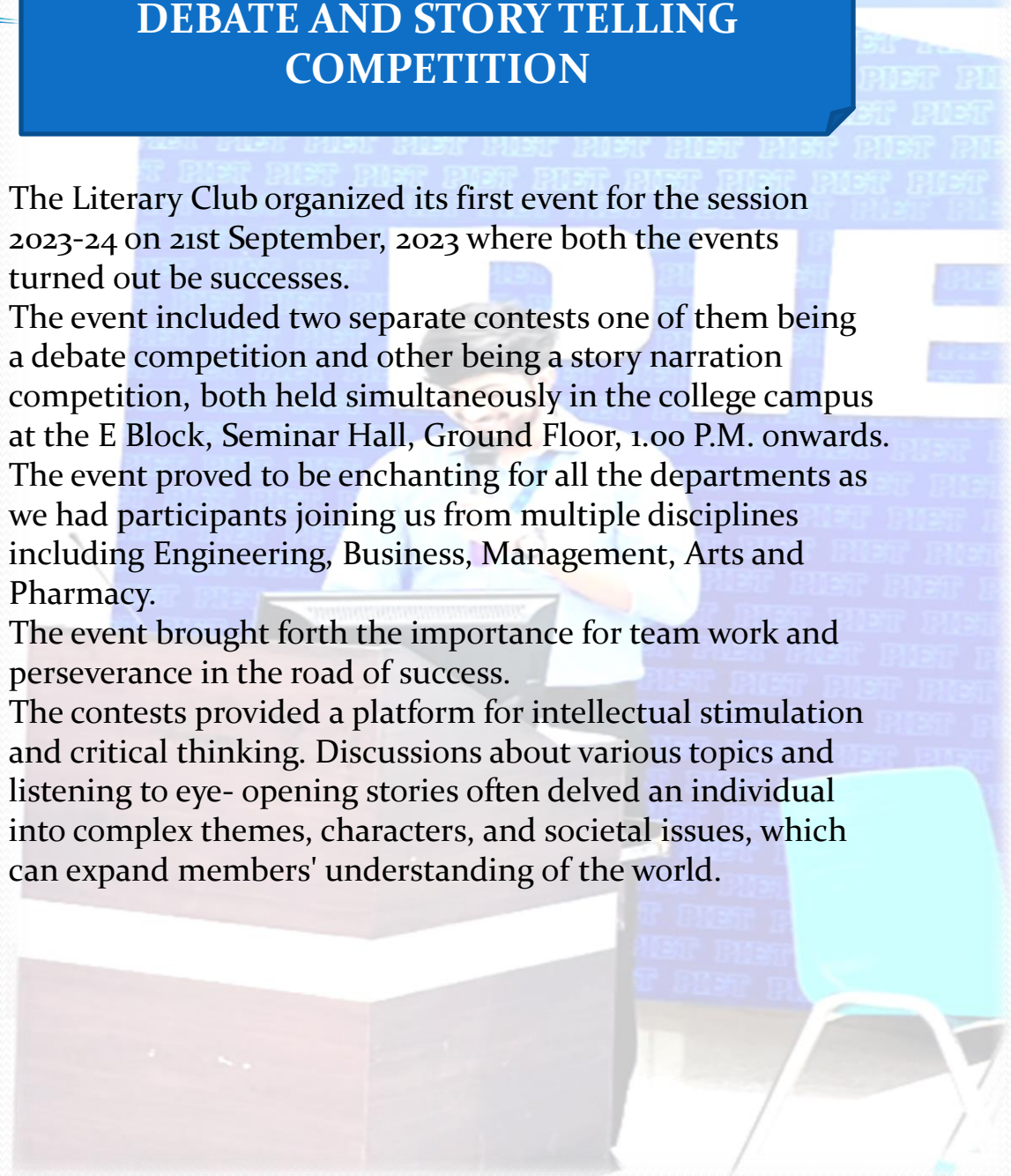
DEBATE AND STORY TELLING COMPETITION

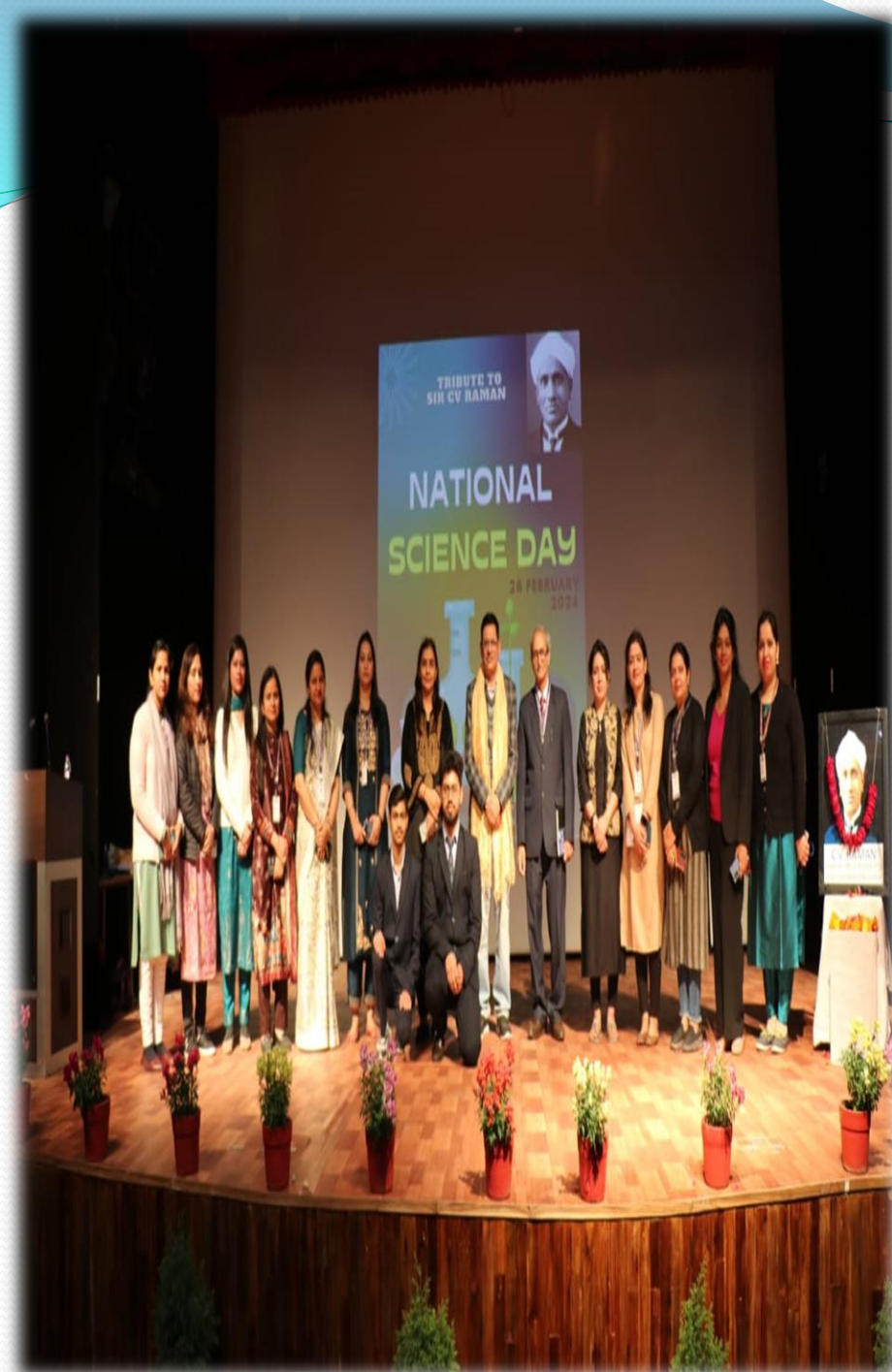

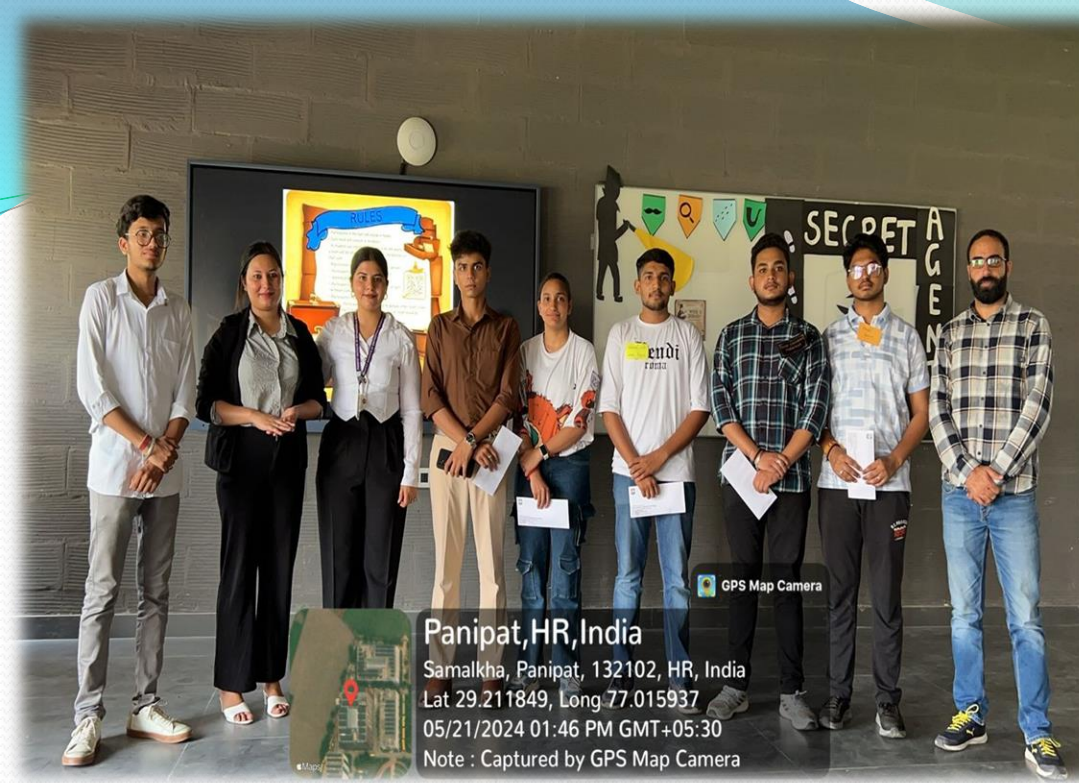
