Minutes of Meeting

A meeting of anti-ragging committee was scheduled to be held on 27 June 2024. The meeting was held in the Director's office, Admin Block ground floor at 3:30PM.

Minutes of meeting:

Chairman Anti ragging committee asked the Chief Proctor to brief about the measures taken by the Anti-ragging committee: The following points were briefed by Chief Proctor

1. Not a single case of ragging was reported in the campus in the session 2023-24.
2. As discussed in the previous meeting (2022-23) regarding installation of CCTVs cameras in every lecture hall and laboratory. In the current session the installation of the cameras is completed.
3. To spread awareness about ragging, the institute publishes anti-ragging warnings and its consequences in the prospectus and college website. Prospectus is provided by the institute to every newly admitted student.
4. The institute has published Anti-ragging warnings in front of every academic block and hotels (Boys & Girls)
5. Special Anti-ragging squads were constituted in the institute to prevent any kind of ragging in the Hostel (Boys and Girls) after academic hours.
6. Surprise visits to critical areas were conducted by the higher authorities (Director, DSW, Deans, and Chief Proctor)
7. The institute organized Anti-ragging awareness and workshops during orientation sessions for the new entrants in the academic session (2023-24).
8. Surprise visits to critical areas were also conducted by the Anti-ragging squad randomly. The areas like canteen, Nescafe, Lawns Common, rooms, etc.
9. As per office order No. D.O.No.f. 1-15/2009(ARC) Pt.III Dated 14th May 2024 from Prof. Manish R. Joshi, Secretary, UGC, India and as per Endst. No.ACM-1 /M.28/24/ 6594-6654 Dated: Jun 3, 2024, of Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra. A revised procedure for students to fill online undertaking and submit Anti-Ragging compliance form on www.antiragging.in/ is implemented for the upcoming session (2024-25).
