Objectives:

• We must take the necessary measures to ensure that there are no instances of ragging on

• All members of the institute, including senior students and freshmen, receive communication about measures to prevent ragging.

• The establishment of the Anti-Ragging Squad and a Mentoring Cell on Ragging are among the measures to ban ragging and eradicate its scourge, as defined by the applicable rules.

• It's crucial to follow the guidelines of the applicable regulations, as established by the regulatory authorities.

• Timely circulation of action taken report to the concerned authorities against anti-ragging in the institute.

• The goal is to stop and eliminate ragging in the surrounding area, the institute campus, and the residence hostels for both boys and girls.

• Aim to establish a secure and encouraging atmosphere for students by firmly upholding a zero-tolerance policy against bullying.

• Aim to sensitize students about the harmful effects of ragging and the disciplinary/criminal actions that will be taken against offenders.

• Aim to foster a culture of respect, empathy, and unity among students.

Functions/Responsibilities:

• To disseminate information on the consequences of ragging through orientation and awareness programs.

 To form and deploy an anti-ragging squad to regularly monitor the campus, hostels, and neighbourhood.

- We regularly review and update the anti-ragging policy to guarantee its effectiveness.

Action Taken Report: 2019-20

- 1. The anti-ragging committee is formed as per the guideline laid down by Honorable Supreme Court of India, UGC, India and AICTE, New Delhi. The following actions are taken by the the committee in session 2019-20
- 2. The committee formed the anti-ragging squad and directed to check the campus and be vigilant especially near the A-block and in canteen area.
- 3. Display the name, contact number and helpline numbers of anti- ragging in the various departments, especially in the A block and central facilities
- 4. Dr. Vijay Kaushik, Chief Warden and Ms. Aastha (warden Girls Hostel) to make every measure to prevent ragging in the hostel especially in the night. They will ensure floor duty of the faculty members staying in the hostel and separate floors and keep a separate floor first year students
- 5. Chairman anti-ragging committee also requested each HODs to check and report the functioning of CCTV installed led in their respective block and report the same immediately if any problem found.
- 6. Academic section instructed to get the affidavit of anti ragging filled by the students as well as parents/guardians.
- 7. Chief proctor spread awareness regarding ragging laws framed by the various governing bodies and the Honorable Supreme Court of India.
- 8. Special awareness sessions are organized regarding anti-ragging in the orientation programme
