#### Objectives:

The anti-ragging committee (ARC) is responsible for spreading awareness and sensitizing students about ragging and its consequences. The committee determines and finalizes the institute's anti-ragging measures, following the directives from the Honourable Supreme Court of India, UGC, and AICTE, New Delhi.

 ARC meetings should be held annually or every week, depending on the frequency of complaints.

• Ensure that students and parents/guardians submit an undertaking or affidavit in the prescribed Performa during the admission process.

• We must take the necessary measures to ensure that there are no instances of ragging on campus.

• All members of the institute, including senior students and freshmen, receive communication about measures to prevent ragging.

• The establishment of the Anti-Ragging Squad and a Mentoring Cell on Ragging are among the measures to ban ragging and eradicate its scourge, as defined by the applicable rules.

• It's crucial to follow the guidelines of the applicable regulations, as established by the regulatory authorities.

• Timely circulation of action taken report to the concerned authorities against anti-ragging in the institute.

• The goal is to stop and eliminate ragging in the surrounding area, the institute campus, and the residence hostels for both boys and girls.

• Aim to establish a secure and encouraging atmosphere for students by firmly upholding a zero-tolerance policy against bullying.

 Aim to sensitize students about the harmful effects of ragging and the disciplinary/criminal actions that will be taken against offenders.

Aim to foster a culture of respect, empathy, and unity among students.

# Functions/Responsibilities:

• To disseminate information on the consequences of ragging through orientation and awareness programs.

• To form and deploy an anti-ragging squad to regularly monitor the campus, hostels, and neighbourhood.

- To investigate complaints related to ragging promptly and impartially.
- To take appropriate disciplinary actions against individuals found guilty of ragging, which may include expulsion, suspension, or legal action as per the severity of the incident.
- To publicize the committee members' contact information will make incident reporting easier.
- We regularly review and update the anti-ragging policy to guarantee its effectiveness.

# Action taken Report: 2022-23

- 1. The academic section is instructed to give the anti-ragging form cum affidavit (for parents/guardians and the student's affidavit) to the newly admitted students, and they were asked to submit the duly signed affidavit by the students and parents/guardians. We keep each student's affidavit in their personnel file. Every student understands that the institute prohibits any form of ragging, and any violation of the rules and regulations set by the Honorable Supreme Court of India and various governing agencies will result in punishment. This will be a punishable act under the Indian Penal Code and college code of conduct.
- 2. The academic session began with multiple awareness sessions.
- 3. The committee formed separate anti-ragging squads to put an end to ragging in both the boys' and girls' hostels.
- 4. The institute publishes anti-ragging warnings on every academic block of the institute to spread awareness among the students.
- 5. The HoDs in the academic block conduct random checks, and the anti-ragging squad patrols the central facilities during academic hours to prevent ragging.
- 6. The website provides the anti-ragging committee's details for quick contact in the event of a ragging incident.
- 7. The orientation session about ragging also included a link to the Google Form.
