Objectives:

The anti-ragging committee (ARC) is responsible for spreading awareness and sensitizing students about ragging and its consequences. The committee determines and finalizes the institute's anti-ragging measures, following the directives from the Honorable Supreme Court of India, UGC, and AICTE, New Delhi.

- ARC meetings should be held annually or every week, depending on the frequency of complaints.
- Ensure that students and parents/guardians submit an undertaking or affidavit in the prescribed Performa during the admission process.
- We must take the necessary measures to ensure that there are no instances of ragging on campus.
- All members of the institute, including senior students and freshmen, receive communication about measures to prevent ragging.
- The establishment of the Anti-Ragging Squad and a Mentoring Cell on Ragging are among the measures to ban ragging and eradicate its scourge, as defined by the applicable rules.
- It's crucial to follow the guidelines of the applicable regulations, as established by the regulatory authorities.
- Timely circulation of action taken report to the concerned authorities against anti-ragging in the institute.
- The goal is to stop and eliminate ragging in the surrounding area, the institute campus, and the residence hostels for both boys and girls.
- Aim to establish a secure and encouraging atmosphere for students by firmly upholding a zero-tolerance policy against bullying.
- Aim to sensitize students about the harmful effects of ragging and the disciplinary/criminal actions that will be taken against offenders.
- Aim to foster a culture of respect, empathy, and unity among students.

Functions/Responsibilities:

- To disseminate information on the consequences of ragging through orientation and awareness programs.
- To form and deploy an anti-ragging squad to regularly monitor the campus, hostels, and neighbourhood.

- To take appropriate disciplinary actions against individuals found guilty of ragging, which may include expulsion, suspension, or legal action as per the severity of the incident.
- To publicize the committee members' contact information will make incident reporting easier.
- We regularly review and update the anti-ragging policy to guarantee its effectiveness.

Action Taken Report: 2023-24

Academic sections circulate the anti-ragging form, also known as an affidavit, to newly admitted students in the 2023-24 session. We ask every student and their parents/guardians to duly sign the affidavit. Every student understands that the Indian Penal Code and college code of conduct will punish any form of ragging in the institute.

1. Committee members emphasized the necessity of installing CCTVs both inside and outside of classrooms. Every corner of the campus boasts CCTV installations. The installation of CCTVs also helps in preventing such incidents.

2. The orientations program began with awareness sessions.

- 3. During the sessions, the Honorable Supreme Court of India and the governing bodies discussed the institute's policies and anti-ragging measures.
- 4. Committee shared the anti-ragging helpline number and the anti-ragging form with the students.
- 5. The website published the anti-ragging committee's details for easy access in the event of a ragging incident.
- 6. The orientation session about ragging also included a link to the Google Form where they can register complain.
- 7. In front of every academic block and central facilities, including the net café, anti-ragging warnings are displayed.
- 8. The institute premises also display anti-ragging posters and videos to enhance the spread of awareness.
