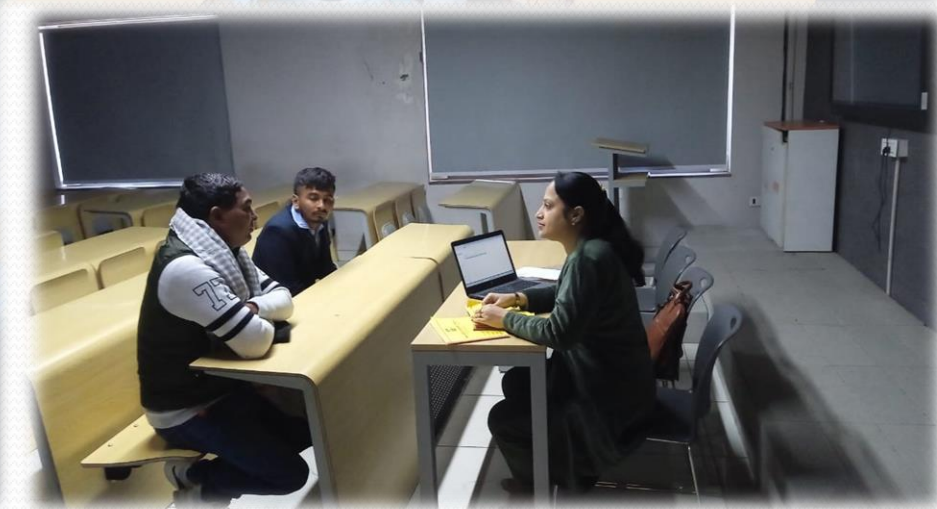


Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM)
